CHENNAI: A bout of rheumatic fever in her childhood had affected Lavanya's heart valve, The 19-year-old from Korukkupet was suffering from breathlessness.

She was found to have severe

mitral regurgitation (leakage of blood backward through the mitral valve each time the left ventricle contracts and moderate pulmonary hypertension. A few months ago, when her parents approached doctors at the Government Stanley Medical

College Hospital and after extensive evaluation, doctors at the cardiothoracic surgery department advised for mitral valve repair or replacement through the routine procedure of middline sternotomy. Dr A. Sivaraman, Professor of Cardiothoracic Surgery, Government Stanley Medical College Hospital, led the surgery. "We then decided to go for a minimal invasive cardiace surgery and carried out the valve replacement in the heart. It was the best solution because for an unmarried girl, a huge scar would be a big setback for marital life in future," said the doctor. He was assisted by Head of Cardiothoracic Surgery and Professor Dr K Dhamodaran, and assistant professor Dr S Vasundaran. Impaled on grill of a gate, man saved by a whisker

Chennai: At 2am on May 20, on-duty cardiothoracic surgeon Dr K S Sarawana Krishna Raja received a call from the trauma ward of the government general hospital. "I thought I heard the caller wrong when he said a patient had reported with a gate pierced through him." said Dr Raja. When he rushed to the ward, he found 29-year-old Vetrivel lying prone on a stretcher with part of a three-feet-long grill inside him.

Around midnight on May 19, Vetrivel, a driver who stayed with his employer in Nungambakkam, had attempted to jump over the closed grill gate. He missed a step and a pointed edge of a grill pierced his back. For close to half an hour, he cried for help, before bystanders noticed his impaled body on the gate.

At lam, the police, who had rushed to the spot, alerted the 108 ambulance service. Fire services personnel used hydraulic cutters to slice the gates, leaving the pierced portion inside. This, doctors say, is what saved Vetrivel's life. "The pierced part was less than an inch from his heart," said Dr A Sivaraman, chief or cardiothoracic department at GH. "If they had tried to dislodge the grill, death would be in instantaneous."

Vertivel was brought to the hospital at 2am.
CT scans revealed that the rusted grill had pierced through the thoracic cavity, punctured his left lung and was lodged very close to the



aorta, the largest artery, and the heart. "He was drowsy and in pain, but other than that all his vitals — his blood pressure and heart beat rate — were normal, "said Dr Sivaraman.

Two and a half hours after the accident, Vetrivel was operated on. The patient was made to lie in semi-prone position during the procedure, which went on for two hours. The grill was extricated with extreme caution and the damaged portion of the lung was sutured.

The case was unlike anything doctors in the hospital had seen. "It was bizarre. We have had patients being brought in with knives still

Driver injured in grill gate mishap given new lease of life

A 29 YEAR-OLD driver was given a new lease of life by doctors in the Rajiv Gandhi Government General Hospital after his lung was damaged when a portion of the grill gate pierced into his chest while trying to jump over the gate at midnight not wanting to disturb the house-owner for the gate keys.

On May 20, around 12 am, betrivel was trying to get out of his owner's house, but the grill gate was locked. Not wanting to disturb his owner's family, he tried to jump over the grill gate unsuccessfully. Vetrivel cried for help but none could rescue him. So fire service personnel were informed. They came and cut the grill using hydraulic cutters leaving the pierced portion of the object inside the patient and rushed him to the Rajiv Gandhi Government General Hospital, said the doctors at a press con-

GH doctor saves life of 42-year-old woman

DC CORRESPONDENT CHENNAI, JAN. 30

Doctors at the Rajiv Gandhi Government General Hospital (RGGGH) saved the life of a 42-year-old woman by performing a complex valve surgery.

The hospital authorities said that Sarswathi from Erode district, who recovered from Covid19 pneumonia in October, was suffering from chest pain, breathlessness and palpitations. Following this, the patient was admitted to the department of Cardiovascular and Thoracic surgery hospital

The valve sparing technique of surgery for thoracic aortic aneurysm was done for the first time at RGGGH

three weeks ago.

During the surgery on Jan. 22, the diseased aneurysmal segment of the aorta was replaced with appropriate sized tube graft which was meticulously designed into trifoliate shape and

sutured to form the aortic root and the damaged aortic valve was repaired. The management of Left Renal Artery stenosis in the form of stenting is planned in the future', said hospital authorities.

The valve sparing technique of surgery for thoracic aortic aneurysm was done for the first time at RGGGH. The surgery, conducted by a team led by Dr A . Sivaraman, lasted 12 hours. The patient recovered well in the post surgery period at the hospital. Heath Secretary J. Radhakrishnan called on the patient at the hospital on Saturday.
